### NOMINATION FORM 2022

***Nominations to be received by the Club by Friday 16th September 2022***

**Objective & Citation:** A national award to publicly recognise an individual's, or company's, significant contribution for the overall benefit of the British Meat & Livestock Industry. To be judged annually but awarded only if there is a nominee of sufficient merit.

**Eligibility:** Open to any person or company within the British Meat & Livestock Industry.

**Award:** The Royal Smithfield Club's Bicentenary Perpetual Trophy of an Armada Dish set with 25 Golden Guineas (value £11,000).

**Nominations:** Nomination Forms, completed by the proposer and accompanied by a citation detailing the contribution of the candidate and reasons for the nomination, must be returned to the Club by the closing date of 16th September 2022. Unsuccessful candidates may be re-nominated in future years.

**Judges:** A Committee appointed by the Royal Smithfield Club will consider the nominations at their meeting to be held in London and via Zoom on Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> September 2022 commencing 10am.

A Committee Member may telephone the proposer to gain additional information prior to the meeting. The Committee reserves the right to disqualify candidates without explanation. The decision shall be final with no correspondence entered into.

**Winner:** The winner will be advised and invited to an appropriate event to receive the award. A News Release will subsequently be sent to the farming press.
